

Period 5 - Unit Plan

This unit continues the course of westward expansion and focuses on the conflicts that resulted from domestic and international migration during this period. Students will learn about the similarities and differences between the North and the South, learn the arguments for and against slavery, and evaluate proposals to resolve the issue of the expansion of slavery in the territories. Finally students will learn how American territorial growth led to sectional tensions, a civil war, and a reconstruction period characterized by both successes and failures. Leaders of the women’s rights movement, looking to expand democracy, will be juxtaposed with leaders of the African American civil rights movement who were hoping to do the same in the face of prejudice and discrimination.
