

Period 4 - Unit Plan

This unit focuses on westward migration; the growth and development of American democracy; and the accompanying economic, territorial, demographic, and cultural changes. Students will learn about the Marshall Court; participate in a Reformers' Convocation; determine the causes and impact of the market revolution; and explain reasons for pro-slavery arguments, anti-immigrant feelings, and restrictive anti-Indian policies at this time.
